Plainfield Public Library's Photography Contest, through the support of the Friends of the Plainfield Public Library announces the 2010 contest to select the best new photographs of Plainfield.

This year's theme: East Side, West Side, All Around The Town!

The contest offers photographers the chance to contribute to the building of Plainfield's visual archives for future historians. All photographs will become part of the Plainfield Public Library's photograph collection. Winning Photographs and selected entries will be exhibited in the Plainfield Public Library in November and December 2010. Cash prizes will be awarded only to photographers whose works relate to this year's theme.

Who should enter?

Professional and amateur photographers of all ages are invited to enter up to five [5] photographs of contemporary images of Plainfield. Every photo must be accompanied by an entry form and conform to contest regulations. A digital image of each photograph is requested.

What are the guidelines?

Each contestant may enter up to five [5] 8x10 or 5x7 contemporary photographs of Plainfield. Photos may be color or B&W and must be submitted on standard photographic paper. There is no cost to enter the contest. **Please complete one entry form [below] for each submission.** *Entries will not be returned and will become the property of Plainfield Public Library.*
