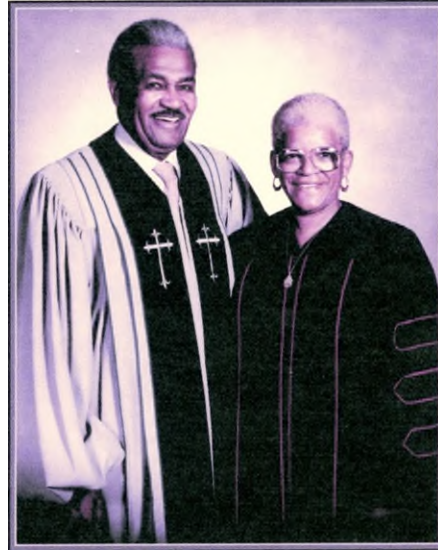

## Reverend Burton C. and Dr. Shirley B. Seabrook Cathie Family Collection, 1954-2015

- Abstract:** The Reverend Burton C. and Dr. Shirley B. Seabrook Cathie Family Collection documents the history, faith, and contributions of a respected and accomplished Plainfield family, from the 1950s through the 2010s. Records in this collection include photographs, scrapbooks, awards, certificates, clippings, ephemera, programs, and record albums.

## Biographical Information

Burton Chadwick Cathie (1923-2001) and Shirley Bernice Seabrook (1926-2017) grew up as neighbors in Atlantic City in the 1930s. Since their fathers had a lot in common and both families shared a similar religious background, they became close friends. Burton Cathie and Shirley Seabrook married in 1941, when they were still teenagers, and moved to Plainfield.

After working in a foundry, a chemical plant, and while working for the Ford Motor Company in Metuchen, Burton Cathie decided to follow in his grandmother's and father's footsteps to become a minister. He received his theological education at the Alma White College of Zarephath, New Jersey and the New Brunswick Theological Seminary and was ordained at a regional Camp Meeting in Uniontown, Pennsylvania in 1957. Reverend Cathie felt compelled to start a church in Plainfield and founded the Community Church of God in 1960, with Shirley Cathie working alongside him as Sunday school teacher and "church mom." She and their daughters, Carolyn and Shirley, also provided music for the church by forming the Cathie Trio. They recorded albums, performed nationally and internationally, and made radio and television appearances.

Reverend Cathie was not only active in the church, but in the Plainfield community as well, as an activist and religious mentor. During the civil unrest of the late 1960s, when Plainfield was devastated by rioting and racial violence, Cathie was key in organizing a citywide revival to help pull the community together. He went on to become an advisor to the Police Board of Plainfield and a member of the Human Relations Commission, the Crime Prevention Committee, and the Concerned Clergy of Plainfield. He was honored by the New Jersey Association of Black Social Workers, Inc., the Black Cultural and Historical Society of Union County, the Community Church of God, and the South Second Street Youth Center. In 2003, three years after his death, the Plainfield Municipal Council designated a portion of West 6<sup>th</sup> Street at the corner of New Street as Burton C. Cathie Plaza.

Like her husband, Shirley Cathie also had a calling to become a minister. After completing her high school equivalency, she went on to earn a Bachelor of Science from Rutgers University, a Master of Arts in Education from Montclair State University, a Doctorate in Education from Rutgers Graduate School of Education, and a Master of Theology from Drew University. While attending school, she served as co-pastor with her husband, who was battling a prolonged illness. When she became ordained in 1994, Dr. Cathie took over as Pastor of the Community Church of God.

In addition to being a minister, Dr. Cathie was a full-time instructor at Rutgers University, Douglass College, and University College at Montclair State University. She served as both state and regional Education Consultant for the New Jersey State Department of Education and was appointed by Plainfield mayor Richard L. Taylor and the Union County College Board as the first director of the Plainfield branch of Union County College. Dr. Cathie was an active member of Zeta Phi Beta,

co-founded The Black Women's History Conference, served as President of the Union County Commission on the Status of Women, and founded the Burton C. and Shirley B. Cathie Family Life Development Center. In 2017, the same year as Shirley Cathie's death, Mayor Adrian O. Mapp and the Plainfield City Council dedicated and re-named Church Street in her honor.

During their careers, and even after retirement, Reverend Burton Cathie and Reverend Dr. Shirley Cathie both received numerous awards and honors from various organizations, institutions, and the city of Plainfield itself. They traveled the world for their ministry work, including trips to El Salvador, Bermuda, Russia, London, France, South Africa, West Africa, Jamaica, Canada, and the Bahamas. Burton and Shirley Cathie's legacy of church and community work lives on in their daughters, Reverend Carolyn Cathie-Waddy-Reid and Chaplain Shirley Cathie-Garrett, who have established successful ministries of their own.

## Scope and Contents

The Reverend Burton C. and Dr. Shirley B. Seabrook Cathie Family Collection includes a variety of materials dating from 1954 to 2015, with bulk dates of the 1970s through the 1990s. Records include photographs and slides, scrapbooks, awards, certificates, clippings, programs, correspondence, and record albums.

The majority of the collection are the awards, plaques, and certificates presented to Reverend Burton Cathie and Dr. Shirley Cathie for their devotion to church and community. Other items of note are the LP and 45 vinyl record albums recorded by the Cathie Trio in the 1960s.

## **Physical Characteristics and Technical Requirements**

The majority of this collection consists of materials, such as paper documents, photographs, and artifacts that do not require any additional technology for access. The negatives and slides would require digitization for easier viewing; at the very least, a loupe and lightbox may be used. The record albums and filmstrips require special equipment to access, which is not available on-site.

## **Series Description**

### **Series 1: Photographs and Scrapbooks [1940s-2007, undated]**

#### **Series Arrangement**

Series 1 is arranged chronologically and in folders, when possible, and is housed in four record storage boxes and one newspaper storage box. Photographs and ephemera removed from albums and scrapbooks have been kept in order. Please note that the dates associated with the majority of slides and photographs are the printed/stamped date when they were developed, not necessarily when they were taken.

#### **Description**

Series 1 contains photographic prints, negatives, and slides of Reverend Burton and Dr. Shirley Cathie and their family, friends, and church congregation. Images document events, trips (both personal and spiritual), and family life. This series also

consists of scrapbooks containing photographs and ephemera, as well as a guest book and a memorial book.

## **Series 2: Awards and Honors [1961-2012, undated]**

### **Series Arrangement**

Series 2 is arranged chronologically and in folders, when possible, and is housed in eight record storage boxes and two newspaper storage boxes.

### **Description**

Series 2 contains numerous plaques, certificates, resolutions, and proclamations awarded to and honoring Reverend Burton C. and Dr. Shirley Cathie from churches, schools, organizations, and the city of Plainfield. This series also contains programs and ephemera from award ceremonies.

## **Series 3: Personal Papers and Artifacts [1956-2011, undated]**

### **Series Arrangement**

Series 3 is arranged chronologically and in folders, when possible, and is housed in seven record storage boxes and one newspaper storage box.

### **Description**

Series 3 contains birth certificates, obituaries and memorials, a wedding anniversary guest book, a family name history certificate for Seabrook, ephemera, plaques, a wooden desk sign, yearbooks, and other school-related material, mostly associated with Shirley Cathie.

## **Series 4: Ministerial and Professional Papers [1979-2012, undated]**

### **Series Arrangement**

Series 4 is arranged chronologically and in folders, when possible, and is housed in one record storage box and one newspaper storage box.

### **Description**

Series 4 contains correspondence, flyers, programs, notes, and writings related to Reverend Burton and Dr. Shirley Cathie's church work, conference work, and subsequent retirements.

## **Series 5: Printed Material [1968-2015]**

### **Series Arrangement**

Series 5 is arranged chronologically and in folders, when possible, and is housed in two record storage boxes and one newspaper storage box.

### **Description**

Series 5 contains clippings, calendars, an art print, two bibles, and a Drew University Alumni directory.

## **Series 6: Audiovisual Material [1962-1989]**

### **Series Arrangement**

Series 6 is arranged chronologically, when possible, and is housed in two record storage boxes and takes up one shelf.

### **Description**

Series 6 contains record albums, including LPs and 45s by the Cathie Trio and a 1962 recording of the Plainfield High School Choral Festival featuring Shirley Cathie (daughter), and filmstrips entitled "Growing Up Black" and "How an Average One-Year-Old Child Behaves."

## **Administrative Information**

### **Access and Restrictions**

The Reverend C. Burton and Shirley B. Seabrook Cathie Family Collection is available for research.

Access is restricted to materials prepared by the Local History department staff. All materials must be viewed in the Plainfield Room and may not be removed to another area of the library without permission of the Library Director or designee. Materials must be handled carefully and kept in order. Materials must not be leaned upon, altered, folded, ripped, or traced upon. Marks may not be added or erased from materials. Materials must be returned directly to Local History department staff and inspected before the researcher leaves the Plainfield Room.

One photocopy may be made (by Plainfield Public Library staff) of each document for the purpose of research; official Local History departmental reproduction fees may apply. Permission to publish must be obtained by the Plainfield Public Library Board of Trustees as delegated to the Library Director. Permission to publish does not constitute a copyright clearance. The researcher is responsible for further copyright restrictions. The Plainfield Public Library is not responsible for the misuse of copyrighted material.
