

Sterner Family Collection Inventory, 1903-2018

The Sterner Family Collection was donated by Steven Sterner in October 2022. Steven's mother-in-law Doris Ann Holland Niedzwiecki (1946-2022) researched and compiled extensive genealogies of her family, as well as that of her husband, Chester Niedzwiecki (1943-2018). Genealogies and scrapbooks are made up of photocopies, printouts, and some original material. They include genealogy reports, family trees, obituaries, census data, military records, certificates, photos, and postcards. Although Chester's family was mainly from Pennsylvania by way of Poland and Ukraine, Doris's family and ancestors mainly settled in New Jersey, including South Amboy and other areas of Middlesex County. Doris was born in East Orange, New Jersey to Harvey and Margaret Slover Holland. She graduated from Central High School in Bayville in Ocean County and Penn State University. Doris's mother Margaret attended Jefferson School and Plainfield High School in the 1930s. Doris was an active member of the Francis Hopkinson Chapter, National Society Daughters of the American Revolution, New Jersey.
