Quick, of Ringoes, died very suddenly at the house of the latter, on Thursday evening last.
Deceased had been living about among his relatives and friends for some months past.
For several weeks previous to his death he had been in Frenchtown, returning to the home of his daughter in Ringoes on Thursday evening. Upon entering the house Mrs.
Quick inquired how he felt and he replied that

was feeling very good, only a little tired. She told him to be seated while she prepared him some supper. He had no sooner seated himself upon a lounge than he fell forward upon his face, gave a few gasps, and was dead. His age was about 76 years. He was a tailor by trade.
