

- Photographs Family photos documenting milestones and personal memories, such as weddings, graduations, birthdays and the like.
- Scrapbooks Albums that highlight family reunions, celebrations, and other occasions.
- Correspondence Handwritten or typed personal letters, postcards, and telegrams.
- Personal Documents Local diplomas, birth certificates, deeds, wills, etc.
- Bible Records Family records of births, deaths, and marriages.
- Diaries & Journals Personal and family histories that shed light on a person's life or local events.
- Books Yearbooks, class directories, published genealogies, etc.
- Other Artifacts, ephemera, and other memorabilia.
