Frequently Asked Questions

1. Do I have to make an appointment to apply at vour acceptance facility?

Yes, we do not take walk-ins.

2. Can I mail in my application or apply online? No, if applying using Form DS-11, you must apply in person.

3. What if I want a passport book and a passport card?

You can apply for a passport book and card simultaneously on Form DS-11 given that you pay both fees.

4. How long will it take to get my passport? For up-to-date processing times visit Travel.state.gov.

5. How can I get my passport fast in case of an emergency?

Urgent Travel Service: Call 1-877-487-2778 from 8 am to 10 pm ET, Mondays - Fridays (closed on federal holidays). Schedule an appointment if you are traveling internationally within 14 days or need a visa within 28 days.

6. I'm behind in child support. Can I get a passport?

You cannot get a U.S. passport if you are behind in child support payments of \$2,500 or more. For more information, please call or visit the U.S. Department of State at Travel.state.gov or (877)-487-2778.

You must apply for a new passport if your previous passport was issued before age 16 or if your previous passport expired 5+ years ago.

All applicants must be present at the time of the appointment.

What is needed to apply for a passport?

1.DS-11 Application:

Must be filled out in <u>black ink</u> before your appointment.

2. Proof of Citizenship:

You will be required to submit this document with your application. This document will be returned in a separate mailing envelope.

3. Proof of Identity:

Valid Driver License, Government photo I.D., or Military I.D.

4. Social Security Number:

You must include your Social Security number on the application if you have one.

5. Photos:

The library offers a passport photo service for \$12 per applicant.

6. Passport Fees:

A separate check or money order, payable to the U.S. Department of State, is required for each application.

7. Acceptance Fee:

The \$35 acceptance fee may be paid by cash or card. You may combine multiple payments to the library. Personal checks or bills bigger than \$50 are not accepted at the library.
